2013 Contest theme: *<u>HISTORICAL BUILDINGS IN MODERN WORLD</u> *

Ahtme Art School would like to invite art students representing art schools and studios to participate in its 10th International Contest of Children's Art.

The Contest is held as part of international project "Climate Change, Cultural Heritage, and Energy Efficient Monuments - CO₂OL Bricks", funded by EU's Baltic Sea Region programme (BSR).

The Contest's objective is to attract public interest and young people, in particular, to the issue of care and preservation of environment, history, and architectural monuments.

Goals of the Contest:

- Creative communication between children from different countries;
- Developing children's imagination and artistic skills;
- Enhancing children's creative self-expression using various forms of art;
- ✓ Increasing participants' intelligence level.

Details and conditions:

- The Contest is held in two age groups:
- 1) 9-13 years

2) 14-19 years

Participants from the younger age are expected to address the general topic of the contest "Historical buildings in modern world"

Participants from the older age group are expected to address one of the following questions in their work:

- How can we save, preserve or change our attitude to historical locations and buildings around us?
- How can heritage preservation save resources and protect the climate?
- Is it possible/necessary to make historical buildings more modern and energy efficient?
