Tourism concepts will be combined with best practise examples of energy-saving refurbishments of historic buildings in the BSR

Malmö, Sweden

There are no specific tours about energy efficiency in historic buildings in Malmö. But there are a lot of activities where the Co₂olBricks issues are being integrated, e.g. guided tours to

- Sege Park area and
- Västra Hamnen, where most of the buildings are new but few historic building are still
 existing.

The guided tours are generally focusing on sustainable city development but issues of energy efficiency in historic buildings are included.

Most of the tours are for special interest visitors and experts (estimated 100 in Västra Hamnen and 50 in SegePark per year). Furthermore 20-30 tours a year are organized for inhabitants and the general public.
